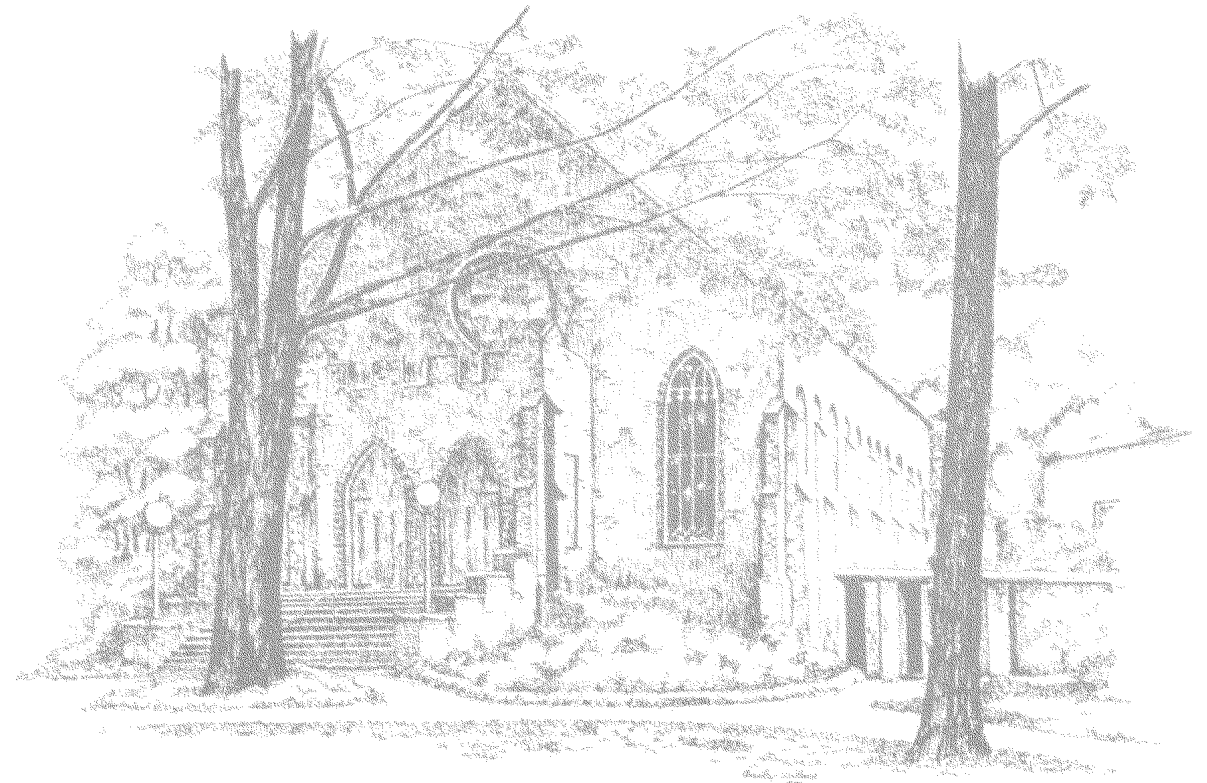

“In the midst of failure, Jesus asks Peter to go deeper, not only into the lake water but also into the experience of God’s abundant and caring inspiration. Jesus present Peter with the vision of a deeper realism that embraces his failed efforts as well as God’s surprising and infinite bounty. Awakened by the vision of a larger world, Isaiah and Peter confess their sinfulness and inadequacy. The issue is not primarily one of behavior or morality, but of awe and wonder before God and the surprising power of Jesus.... While we can never fully fathom the nature of divine revelation, the experiences of Isaiah and Peter remind us that life-transforming inspiration may be right around the corner, in the next encounter, or in today’s worship. Once we are open to God, we will find ourselves sailing into deeper waters guided by God’s inspiration.”
