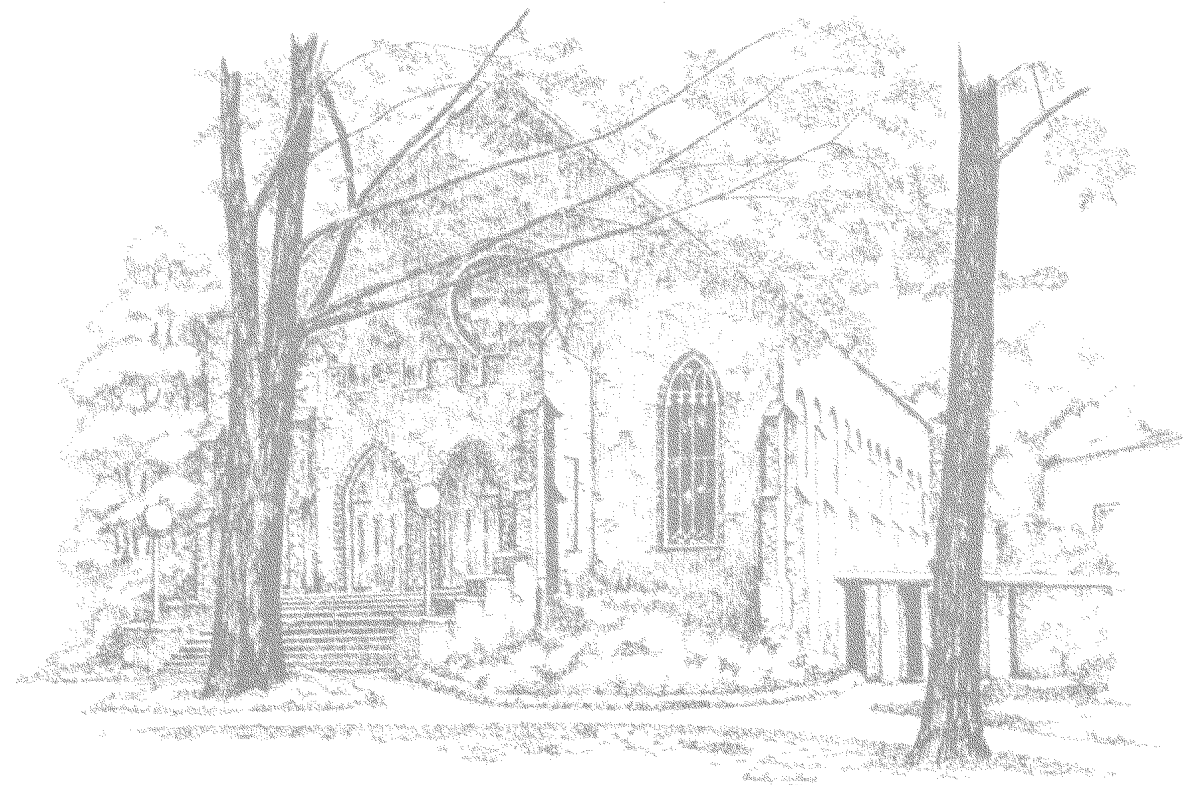

Meditation

“Paul says in Romans 4 that Father Abraham trusted in the God who ‘justifies the *ungodly*,’ and in Romans 5 he writes those key words, ‘While we were still helpless, Christ died for the ungodly.’ Here is the irreducible core, the nerve center, the heart and soul of the Christian faith. Notice that it is the exact opposite of the good old American gospel, ‘God helps those who help themselves.’... Paul has always made people nervous, and this is the reason. He seems to be knocking the props out from everything religious and controllable. Religion, being a human construct, allows people to create a God after their own image instead of the other way around. Religion makes God more manageable by setting up conditions that God is bound by.... Yet Paul insists that God does not sit at the summit of human religious achievement, waiting for us to make it to the top; God is down in the valleys where sinful human beings are struggling with their daily lives.”
