

Little Folks News – September 2011

The **Little Folks of Fourth's Fall Program begins Tuesday, September 6.** These last weeks in July have been busy with saying tearful good-byes to children who are going off to new schools this fall. The teachers have made the switch from their summer rooms to their new fall classrooms and are busy rearranging furniture and planning exciting activities and intriguing projects for the coming year. New parents and their children have been dropping in on a daily basis to visit their rooms and become introduced to the new teachers. These visits also give parents an opportunity to pick up and fill out the new paperwork. Since Little Folks is licensed by the S.C, Department of Social Service, the paperwork must be updated yearly. Each year I change the color of the paperwork so that I can tell at a glance if a child's file is current. Last year all of the paperwork was blue. The blue paperwork is now obsolete. This year, the color is **YELLOW.** **Even returning students must have new paperwork on file, so, if you have not filled out and turned in a Yellow packet of papers for each of your children, we need them ASAP.** We also must have a current official South Carolina Immunization Form on file for each student. You have to get these from your doctor or the Health Department. Be sure to bring one to Little Folks on or before your child begins his/her first day.

**Fall registration fees are due.** Be sure to remember this when you are writing your September tuition check. Once again, the Fall fee is \$100 for the first child and \$75 for each additional child. This fee is for September 2011 through May 2012 session. There will be another for the 2012 summer session that you will pay in the spring. Even if you think you've already paid the fall fee, check with me to be absolutely sure.

**Once again our tuition is \$16 per day per child.** Please pay at the beginning of the month. You can drop your check in my office in the mailbox on the wall beside the door.

We're all looking forward to our new school year. It's going to be an exciting time with new teachers, new classrooms, and new students. What will remain the same is our love for your children and our determination to make your child's environment a unique place in which to grow, explore, and learn.
